



Prof. Dionysis Asimakopoulos has been a Member of the Waste Sector of the Regulatory Authority for Waste, Energy and Water since 2024.

He has served as a Member of the Board of Directors of the municipal corporation “National Garden – Metropolitan Green S.A.”, a Member of the Board of Directors of the Athens Water Supply and Sewerage Company (EYDAP), where he also served as Deputy Chairman during the final year of his term, Vice-Chairman of the Board of the Centre for Renewable Energy Sources and Energy Saving (CRES), and Member of the Board of the National Centre for the Environment and Sustainable Development (NCESD).

He collaborated with the World Bank on the assessment of the thematic area “Transboundary Waters between Greece and Bulgaria – Issues,” and with the OECD on the evaluation of the thematic area “Water Resources Management (the Greek case).”

He is Professor Emeritus of the School of Chemical Engineering at the National Technical University of Athens, where he taught from 1981 to 2017, and served as Coordinator of the School’s Energy and Environmental Systems Management Unit.

He is the author of more than 200 publications in scientific journals and conference proceedings, as well as books and academic textbooks. He has worked as an external evaluator/expert with various organizations in Greece and abroad and has participated in more than 60 funded research and educational projects over the past 30 years. His current research activities focus on the energy upgrading of public buildings, water resources

management, climate change adaptation, environmental systems management and protection, and energy systems management.

He holds a BSc in Physics from Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and a PhD in Systems Analysis from Queen Mary College, University of London.
